EXPECTATIONS:

- Students are expected to attend all rehearsals and performances.
- Students are expected to have their music & instruments for rehearsals and performances.
- Students are expected to practice at home regularly.
- Students are expected to dress appropriately for performances.
- Students are expected to be on time for rehearsals and performances.
- Students are expected to complete assignments (band music / lesson book) on time.
- Students are expected to follow the classroom rules.

CLASSROOM RULES:

- Students are to observe silence when directed.
- Students need to be in their seats ready to go at the beginning of class.
- Students are to follow directions the first time given, and each time after that.
- No talking while the director is giving instructions.
- Be kind.
- Be attentive.
- Be polite.

The classroom rules are quite simple and can be summarized by the following thoughts....

"Be where you are supposed to be, doing what you are supposed to be doing, when you are supposed to be doing it. Always remember that the C-G-D Band is a reflection of your character, of our school, of our families, and of our community. Behave in such a manner that your family and teachers would be proud. Take pride in the Band and understand that you are the best of the best."

GRADING:

Students will earn a letter grade in band. The band grade is based upon practicing, lessons, rehearsals, performances, and effort.

GRADING POLICY: EVALUATION & WEIGHTING

20% OF THE GRADE DEPENDS UPON INDIVIDUAL PRACTICE

Each student is required to practice every week. Students will keep a practice log that needs to be signed/initialed by a parent/guardian every week. Practice minutes will be collected once every 4 to 6 weeks during band lessons or after rehearsals. A good practice target to achieve would be 15 minutes a day, 5 days a week. Students are expected to practice their weekly lesson book assignment, band music, and to review older materials.

*Understanding that there are more demands on 7th & 8th Grade Students, along with additional extra-curricular opportunities, the practice requirements have been altered. 7th & 8th Grade Students who are still in book 1 will be required to practice more to provide the opportunity to catch up with their bandmates.

25% OF THE GRADE DEPENDS UPON LESSONS

Each student will be scheduled for 5 lessons every Hex. The lesson grade will be based upon attendance and preparation.

- Attendance
 - **o** 5 + Lessons per Hex = A +
 - **o** 4 Lessons per Hex = A
 - **o** 3 Lessons per Hex = B
 - **o** 2 Lessons per Hex = C
 - **o** 1 Lessons per Hex = D

- Preparation
 - Students will be given a weekly assignment in the lesson book and are expected to prepare their assignment as well as the band music during their practice times.

25% OF THE GRADE DEPENDS UPON PERFORMANCES

- Large Group Performances
 - Absences will either be excused or unexcused depending upon the circumstance. Please bring Mr. Klaver a note from home before an anticipated absence or during the next rehearsal following the absence.

10% OF THE GRADE DEPENDS UPON EFFORT, ATTITUDE, & RELIABILITY

- Do your best
- Be polite
- Follow instructions
- Be positive

CHAIR PLACEMENTS:

-For Concert Band, students will be seated according to where they are in their lesson books, with the student who is the furthest along as the "First Chair" player.

SCHOOL OWNED INSTRUMENTS and PERCUSSION USAGE:

The students are not charged any fees to use the school horns and percussion instruments. The school pays for general maintenance and repair of instruments. Percussionists need to provide their own snare drum sticks.

Students are expected to show extreme care in using school horns and percussion instruments. They are responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of his or her instrument. If repairs are needed, notify Mr. Klaver or Mr. Wesselink immediately. Anyone showing misuse or neglect will not be allowed to use an instrument and will be expected to pay any cost for repairing the instrument.

REEDS / VALVE OIL / SUPPLIES:

-The school does keep a limited supply of supplies on hand for resale.

-Reeds / Valve Oil / Supplies need to be purchased before school or after school.

-Reeds are sold at a discounted rate from the music store and will be sold in a quantity of 3.
